



# In-Between Numbers

## What You Need

- In-Between Numbers Digit Cards, 4 sets of 0–9 per player

## How to Play

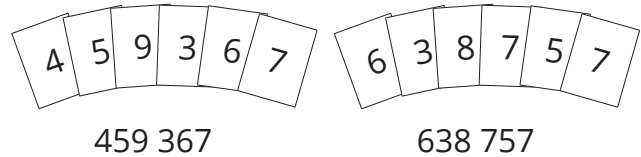
- Play with a partner.
- Each player shuffles his or her deck of cards and places it face down in a pile.
- Each player takes the top six cards from his or her pile and arranges them, in the order drawn, to create a six-digit number.
- Each player then takes the next six cards from his or her pile and arranges them to create the greatest number possible between the two numbers.
  - If neither player can create in-between numbers, each player draws six more cards.
  - If only one player can create an in-between number, that player wins the round.
- The player with the greater in-between number scores 1 point.
- The first player to score 10 points wins.

## Other Ways to Play

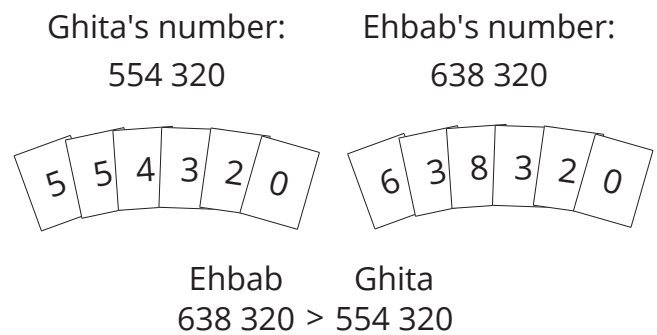
- Instead of using digit cards:
  - Use number rollers (0–9).
  - Use a spinner (0–9).
- The player with the lesser in-between number wins each round.

## Example

Ghita and Ehab use their top six cards to create two numbers. They place the cards in the order drawn.



Ghita and Ehab each draw another six cards. They arrange them in any order to make the greatest in-between number possible.



Ehab's in-between number is greater, so he scores 1 point.
