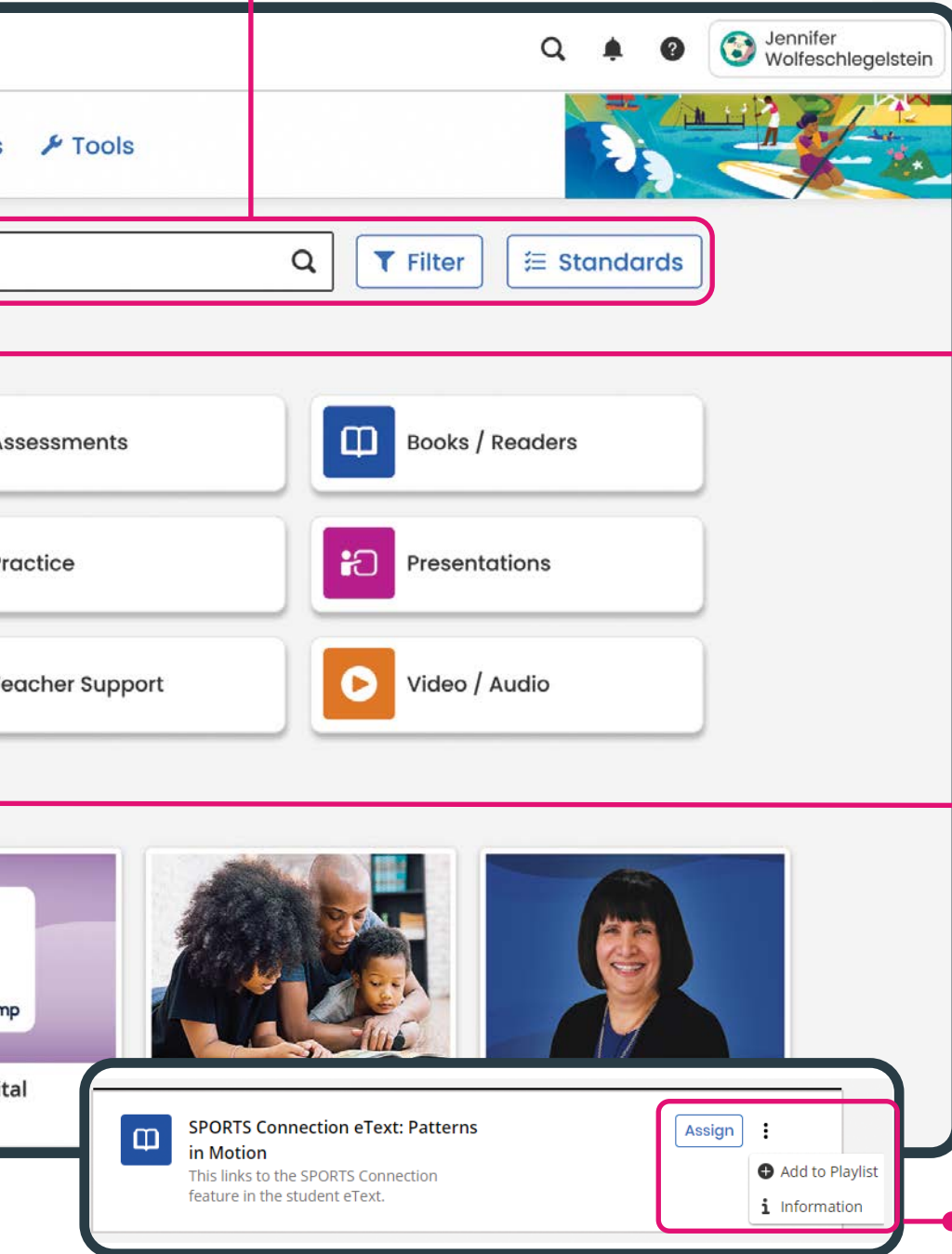





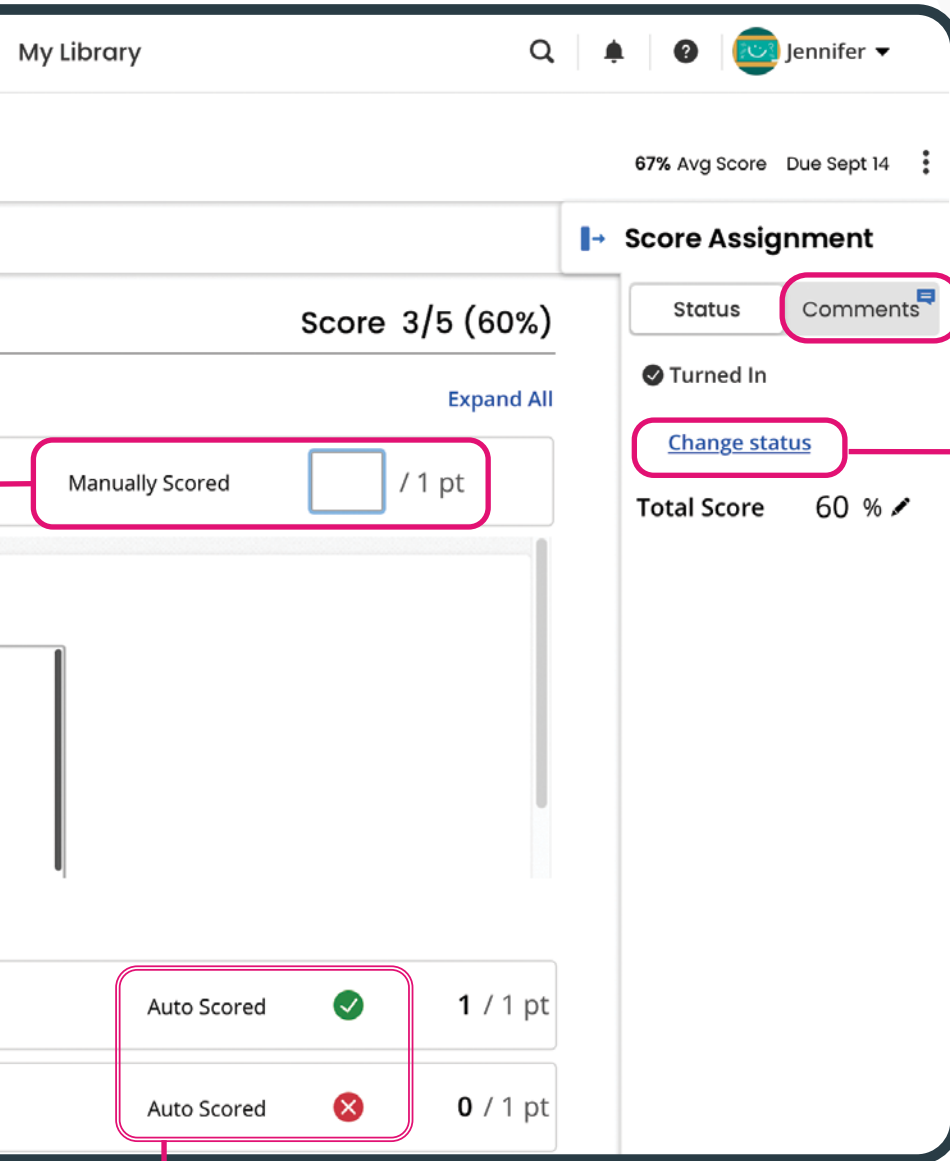

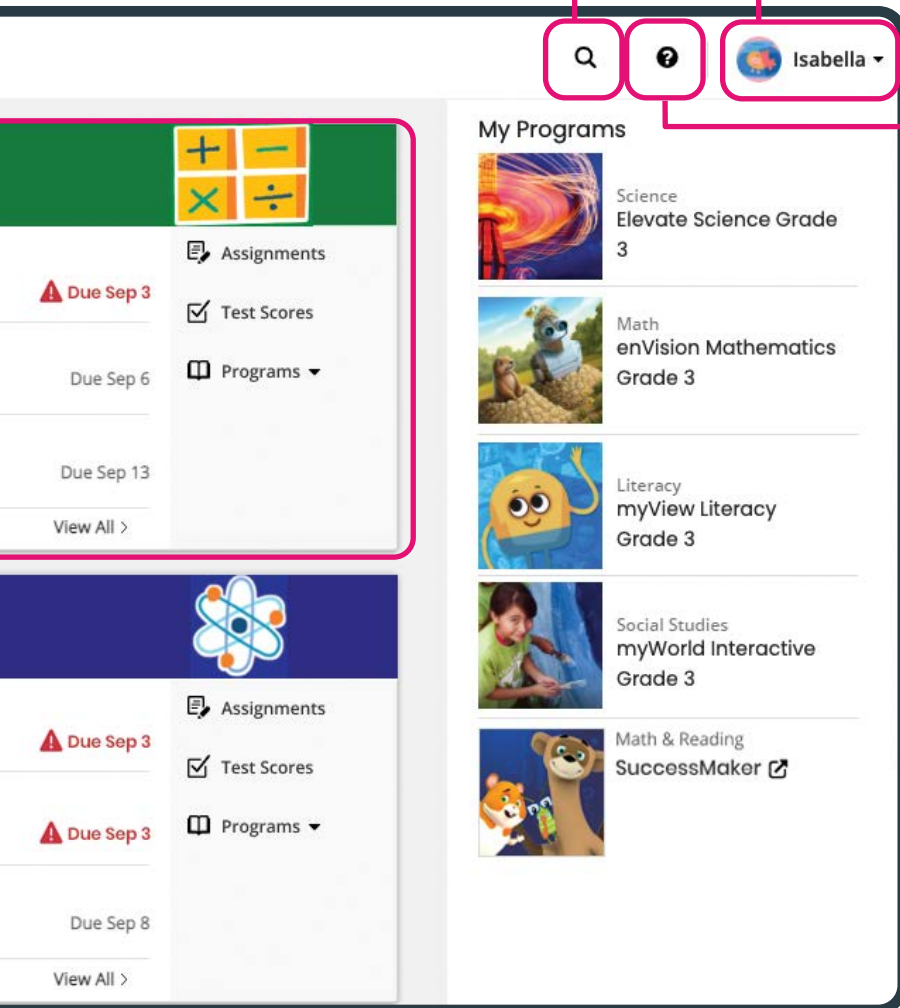
## Student Profile
